Roger Dale Bozman, age 78 of Portage, IN was born on February 16th, 1945 and passed peacefully in his home on Monday, May 1st, 2023.

Roger was born in Warrior Mines, West Virginia to Harmon and Annie May Bozman, née Woods and was raised in Alabama. He and his family transplanted to Indiana in the mid 1950s.
